The MSSA Executive Board had an emergency meeting on August 6th, 2020, to decide the fate of The MD State Shoot.

After a long discussion on the logistics of holding a state shoot, with a possibility of a large attendance, the MSSA executive board, regrettably, has decided, by a unanimous vote, to cancel the 2020 MD State Shoot.

The trap line personnel the MSSA normally uses, (4H), are under a restriction and unable to participate at this time. An alternative proposal, essentially using the same 4H kids was discussed. However, the board did not feel confident that this would be successful due to issues of insurance coverage and parental consent. The State and County mandates for COVID-19, would make it virtually impossible for hard working volunteers to run the shoot and participate in the program.
